Tunisia is hosting this year the 8th edition of the Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD), which will focus on three main areas, namely, (1) "Achieving sustainable and inclusive growth with a reduction in economic inequalities", (2) "Achieving a sustainable and resilient society based on human security" and (3) "Building sustainable peace and stability by supporting Africa's efforts".
